12 Legislature; and

14 the year that the Girl Scouts was founded, is a bipartisan

5 living by reducing bullying and relational aggression; and

6                   WHEREAS, through the Girl Scout Leadership  
7 Experience, girls 5-17 discover themselves and their values,  
8 connect with other girls, and take action to make the world a  
9 better place; now therefore,

10                  BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE LEGISLATURE OF  
11 ALABAMA, That March 12, 2015, is hereby designated as Girl  
12 Scouts Advocacy Day In Alabama, and we proudly recognize the  
13 commitment Girl Scouting has made to support the leadership  
14 development of Alabama girls.
