10 WHEREAS, we note the death of Mr. Chauncey Wood,
11 Jr., local realtor and artist, on January 31, 2015, with deep
12 sadness and regret; his invaluable life of 87 years is
13 commended and celebrated with tremendous thanksgiving; and

14 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. Wood, a native of
15 Montgomery, leaves a void in the lives of his loving family,
16 many friends, and the entire community, where he was highly
17 regarded; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Wood was a 1947 graduate of Sidney
19 Lanier High School, where he was a star player on the football
20 and track teams, and a 1951 graduate of Auburn University,
21 where he was a sprinter on the track team; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Wood served as the Executive Secretary
23 for the Alabama Sheriff's Association from 1965-1969 and was
24 instrumental in starting the Dallas County Boy's Ranch; he
25 held a number of advertising positions with national retail
26 companies and served as a broker and owner of Azalea Real
27 Estate; and

1 WHEREAS, through the years, Mr. Wood earned
2 widespread respect for his tireless dedication and exceptional
3 abilities while serving as President of Chauncey Wood Public
4 Relations, Inc., as executive secretary of the state Sheriff's
5 Association as business manager of the Downtown Business
6 Association, President of the Montgomery Advertising Club, and
7 a two-time Chairman of United Appeal's public relations
8 committee; and

9 WHEREAS, he was married to the late Louise McClennan
10 Wood of Grand Bay; and

11 WHEREAS, survivors include his daughter, Shawn
12 Christensen, and son, Chauncey D. Wood, III; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Wood was a valued member of the
14 community; although his presence is greatly missed, his memory
15 is cherished in the hearts and minds of all those who were
16 fortunate enough to know him; now therefore,
