2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,  
3 HONORING THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD.  
4

5 WHEREAS, highest commendation is herein conveyed to  
6 the venerable Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd, which is  
7 observing its 160th Anniversary in the Year of Our Lord 2014;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd  
10 is the oldest Black Episcopal Congregation in the State of  
11 Alabama, having been fostered in Trinity Church, when freed  
12 men and slaves were worshiping in Trinity's gallery; and

13 WHEREAS, on May 28, 1854, with the confirmation of  
14 seven devout Black members, the Episcopal Church of the Good  
15 Shepherd was established; and

16 WHEREAS, in the beginning, services were held in the  
17 "Love and Charity Hall" at Dearborn and St. Michael Streets in  
18 Mobile, Alabama; other sites were later acquired, and the  
19 church is now located on Donald Street in Mobile, where it is  
20 a monument to faith and fortitude; and

21 WHEREAS, through the years, the church has expanded  
22 in membership and ministries, becoming a viable and visible  
23 part in the development of the Diocese of the Central Gulf  
24 Coast; and

1               WHEREAS, historical milestones include 1896, when  
2               the Reverend James N. Thompson became the first  
3               African-American Priest and Rector of the Church; and

4               WHEREAS, on September 15, 2008, the Reverend Nancy  
5               Threadgill was called as the twelfth Rector and second female  
6               to serve as Rector; and

7               WHEREAS, the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd  
8               continues to serve as a beacon of faith and a source of  
9               spiritual strength in the Mobile area, building on its  
10              illustrious history; now therefore,

11              BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
12              HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That it is a privilege to honor the  
13              dedicated leaders and devout members of the Episcopal Church  
14              of the Good Shepherd, past and present, and it is directed  
15              that a copy of this resolution of tribute be provided to the  
16              church in recognition of 160 years of service to God and  
17              mankind, along with best wishes for the future.
