13 Tigers have won 12 state championships overall; and

15 unwavering commitment to excellence, the Lady Tigers defeated
16 Pisgah 70-39 to earn the fourth consecutive state championship
17 and now have an 84-game winning streak; and

20 Covington, Maggie Covington, Allison Craig Cruce, Tamia

23 Darah Wiginton; and

24 WHEREAS, under the expert guidance and leadership of
25 Head Coach Brant Llewellyn and assistant coach Carla Clemons,

1 the Lady Tigers have excelled at every opportunity; the Lady
2 Tigers finished the season with a stellar 39-0 record,
3 breaking their own record for the most wins in a season; and

4 WHEREAS, in the championship game against Pisgah,
5 the Lady Tigers shot 50 percent from the field holding Pisgah
6 to 25.4 percent shooting; Ivy Wallen, who scored a game-high
7 22 points, was named the tournament Most Valuable Player while
8 Allison Craig Cruce tallied 16 points and 12 rebounds; and

10 High School Girls Basketball Team are the source of
