9 is attributed to the dedicated and loyal long-term service of
10 Joe Whitt, who has provided the highest quality of services;

12 WHEREAS, indeed, Joe Whitt has been a valuable mover
13 and shaker for Auburn University for 34 years in various roles
14 and continues to serve Auburn University with the highest
15 quality of professionalism; his record of excellence and
16 service reflects immense honor upon the entire State of
17 Alabama; now therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
19 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of outstanding
20 success, Joe Whitt is highly honored and commended for 34
21 years of exemplary service to Auburn University and it is
