8 COMMENDING OFFICERS JASON MOORE AND REYNARD ROBINSON
9 OF THE HUNTSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AS THE RECIPIENTS OF THE
10 2015 LEGISLATIVE MEDAL OF HONOR FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

12 WHEREAS, it is a great privilege to recognize
13 Officers Jason Moore and Reynard Robinson of the Huntsville
14 Police Department as the recipients of the 2015 Alabama
15 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement, Alabama's
16 highest law enforcement award for extraordinary courage in the
17 line of duty; and

18 WHEREAS, on April 4, 2014, Officers Moore and
19 Robinson expertly and courageously handled a domestic dispute
20 that involved a highly volatile offender, who threatened the
21 officers and shot Officer Moore in the face, neck, and
22 shoulder; and

23 WHEREAS, Officer Moore, who was in immediate need of
24 medical attention, fought the pain and severity of his
25 injuries and returned fire upon the offender; Officer Robinson
26 continued to provide invaluable cover fire so Officer Moore
27 could reach safety; and

1 WHEREAS, the SWAT team arrived and secured the inner
2 perimeter, and Officer Robinson was safely evacuated; the
3 conflict lasted several hours and resulted in the eventual
4 death of the offender; and

5 WHEREAS, Officers Moore and Robinson are worthy
6 exemplars of those caring and dedicated men and women who
7 stand ever ready to serve and protect, and they are truly
8 deserving of this significant honor; now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize and most
11 highly honor Huntsville Police Officers Jason Moore and
12 Reynard Robinson as the distinguished recipients of the 2015
13 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement and direct that
14 a copy of this resolution be provided to each of them as
15 evidence of our admiration and esteem.
