3 DESIGNATING THE PORTION OF INTERSTATE 20 WEST/59
4 SOUTH BETWEEN MILE MARKERS 115 AND 116 AS THE OFFICER MARY
5 FREEMAN SMITH MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

7 WHEREAS, on October 23, 2006, Mary Freeman Smith, an
8 officer of the City of Fairfield Police Department, was shot
9 and killed after responding to a suspicious vehicle report;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Smith had served with the Fairfield
12 Police Department for two months and had previously served
13 with the Birmingham Police Department for 21 years; and

14 WHEREAS, the bravery, devotion to duty, and love of
15 community of this fallen hero have forever earned her a place
16 in the hearts and memories of the citizens she willingly
17 risked her life to protect, an honor that comes at enormous
18 cost to the people who knew her best, loved her most, and
19 remember her as a relative and friend; and

20 WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that we
21 remember and honor Officer Smith for her service; now
22 therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
24 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the portion of Interstate
25 Highway 20 West/59 South between mile markers 115 and 116 be

1 designated as the Officer Mary Freeman Smith Memorial Highway
2 in honor of her service and sacrifice to our state and the
3 City of Fairfield.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
5 officials are requested to place and maintain signs or markers
6 as provided in this resolution.
