8 WHEREAS, a resident of Phenix City, Alabama, since
9 1934, Roy Mitchell Greene has dedicated his life to giving
10 back to his community; and

11 WHEREAS, a veteran of World War II, who came home to
12 Phenix City after the war to establish his law practice, Roy
13 Greene served as a city judge, a city commissioner, a county
14 attorney, District Attorney for the 26th Judicial Circuit,
15 Lieutenant Colonel on the staff of Governor John Patterson, a
16 member of the Alabama Legislature, and had a pivotal role in
17 bringing radio, newspaper, cable television, and faster
18 Internet to East Alabama; and

19 WHEREAS, married to Janie Moore Greene for over 60
20 years, the family has generously donated to the local
21 communities, local schools, and charitable causes; and

22 WHEREAS, it is both appropriate and desirable to
23 honor Roy Mitchell Greene, who has made the lives of his
24 fellow citizens better and has brought honor and respect to
25 Alabama through his tireless and dedicated contributions to

1 Phenix City, Russell County, this state, and the country; now
2 therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in honor of Roy Mitchell
5 Greene, we declare that the portion of Highway 431 south of
6 Phenix City, Alabama, and north of the City of Seale, Alabama,
7 be named the "Roy M. Greene Highway."

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
9 officials be requested to place and maintain signs or markers
10 as provided in this resolution.
