8 ESTABLISHING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE TO STUDY
9 MUNICIPAL POLICE JURISDICTION LAWS.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
12 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That there is established the Joint
13 Interim Committee To Study Municipal Police Jurisdiction Laws.

15 (a) The committee shall be composed of the following
members:

16

17 (1) Six members of the Alabama Senate. The President
18 Pro Tempore shall select three Senate members and the
Lieutenant Governor shall select three Senate members.

20 (2) Six members of the House of Representatives
selected by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

22 (b) The goals of the committee are to study Alabama
23 laws relating to the police jurisdictions of municipalities
and make suggestions for the improvement of these laws.

25 (c) The committee membership shall be inclusive and
26 shall reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban, rural,
and economic diversity of the state.

(d) The committee shall be charged with the following duties and responsibilities:

(1) Upon adjournment of the 2015 Regular Legislative Session, the committee shall schedule an initial meeting to organize and discuss a plan of action and shall meet as necessary thereafter to achieve its goals.

(2) The committee shall report its findings and any proposed legislation to the Speaker of the House and President Pro Tempore of the Senate on the first day of the 2016 Regular Session, whereupon it shall stand dissolved and discharged of any further duty or liability.

(e) Upon request of the chair of the committee, the Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House of Representatives shall provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the committee.

(f) Members of the committee shall be entitled to their regular legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day he or she attends a meeting of the committee in accordance with Amendment 871 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901. These payments shall be paid out of any funds appropriated to the use of the Legislature.

(g) The committee is requested to structure its meeting schedule in such a manner that not more than \$2,500 will be expended for the work of the committee.
