5 WHEREAS, we deeply regret and are greatly saddened
6 to learn of the death of Mr. Frank Henderson Riddick of
7 Huntsville, Alabama, on December 28, 2015, at 86 years of age;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. Riddick leaves a void in
10 the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the entire
11 community, where he was highly regarded; and

12 WHEREAS, a Huntsville native, Mr. Riddick served
13 with the United States Army during the Korean War before
14 graduating from Auburn University; he was employed with the
15 Redstone Arsenal Army Missile Command and Teledyne Brown
16 Engineering; and

17 WHEREAS, the son of a Madison County Sheriff, Mr.
18 Riddick served the citizens of Huntsville and Madison County
19 as a member of the Huntsville City Council and the Alabama
20 House of Representatives; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Riddick retired as Probate Judge of
22 Madison County in 2000 before becoming Director of
23 Governmental Affairs for the Huntsville Area Association of
24 Realtors; he served on numerous local boards including the

1 Madison County Mental Health Board and the Harris Home for
2 Children; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Riddick was a faithful and devoted
4 member of Chase Park Church of Christ; and

5 WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved and devoted
6 wife of 59 years, Barbara McDaniel Riddick; son, Madison
7 County Commissioner Phil Riddick (Rebecca); daughter, Teresa
8 Chilek (Greg); sisters, Miriam Riddick Dendy and Minnie
9 Frances Riddick Nash; and grandson, Steven Henderson Riddick;

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Riddick was a valued member of the
12 community; although his presence is greatly missed, his memory
13 is cherished in the hearts and minds of all those who were
14 fortunate enough to know him; now therefore,
