8 HONORING SCOTTY KENNEDY FOR HIS SIGNIFICANT CIVIC  
9 CONTRIBUTIONS ON THE OCCASION OF THE RED BAY GARDEN CLUB'S  
10 ANNUAL ARBOR DAY CELEBRATION.

12 WHEREAS, it is a tremendous privilege to honor  
13 Scotty Kennedy for his significant civic contributions on the  
14 momentous occasion of the Red Bay Garden Club's Annual Arbor  
15 Day Celebration; and

16 WHEREAS, a stately red oak tree will be planted in  
17 honor of Scotty Kennedy on March 9, 2016; and

18 WHEREAS, notably, Mr. Kennedy has actively served  
19 the Red Bay Tree Commission and the Bay Tree Council for the  
20 Performing Arts; his service with the Bay Tree Council for the  
21 Performing Arts included appearing and starring in more than  
22 30 productions, directing nine productions, and working on  
23 props and scenery; he was selected as a background actor in  
24 the independent film, "When I Find the Ocean"; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Kennedy has also served on the boards  
26 of the Red Bay Educational Foundation, Franklin County Chamber

1 of Commerce and Dr. Walker Dempsey Foundation for Red Bay  
2 Hospital; and

3 WHEREAS, as a Civitan Club member and past  
4 president, he has been involved with numerous projects  
5 including the Red Bay History Book, the Tammy Wynette Benefit  
6 concerts for Red Bay School, and the establishment of the Red  
7 Bay Museum; he has also poured efforts into Red Bay's  
8 Centennial Celebration, First Baptist Church Centennial, and  
9 the Smithsonian Museum on Main Street Traveling Exhibit, "The  
10 Way We Worked"; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Kennedy is a 1977 graduate of Northwest  
12 Alabama State Junior College and 1980 graduate of The  
13 University of Mississippi, where he earned a Bachelor of Fine  
14 Arts Degree in Design with an emphasis in Graphics; he owns  
15 Scotty Kennedy Photography and a custom frame shop; he has won  
16 several awards in portrait and wedding photography at the  
17 state level with the Professional Photographers of Alabama and  
18 Mississippi; and

19 WHEREAS, it is fitting and appropriate to honor  
20 Scotty Kennedy and his significant contributions to the  
21 beautification and environmental efforts of the Red Bay area  
22 on the occasion of the Red Bay Garden Club's Annual Arbor Day  
23 Celebration; now therefore,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF  
25 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Scotty Kennedy is honored and
