9 CLARENCE CASON AWARD.

11 WHEREAS, it is a tremendous privilege to recognize
12 Hardy Jackson, on his selection for the 2016 Clarence Cason
13 Award in nonfiction writing; the University of Alabama College
14 of Communication and Information Sciences bestows this honor
15 annually to a recipient with a strong connection to Alabama
16 and whose writings have made a critical contribution to the
17 journalism and literature of the South; and

19 teaching and writing about the history of Alabama; a columnist

2 The Anniston Star, is known to tell history in a personal and
3 authentic way to make history come alive for his students; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson has attained great success by
5 demonstrating his dedication and hard work which made him
6 deserving of the Clarence Cason Award in nonfiction writing
7 through his commitment to excellence in his career and his
8 writings; now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
10 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Hardy Jackson is most highly
11 commended, and this resolution is offered with heartiest
