19 students in our great state to be selected as a U.S.

22 initially created by executive order of the President in 1964
23 to highlight the achievements of some of the most
24 distinguished graduating high school seniors in the nation and
25 has since been expanded to include the recognition of students
26 who portray extraordinary gifts in visual, creative, and

2 achievement in career and technical education fields; and

3 WHEREAS, Lindsey is the accomplished daughter of
4 Tommy and Tina Waggoner and a flutist in the Music Department
5 at the Alabama School of Fine Arts in Birmingham; and

6 WHEREAS, notably, she scored a perfect 36 on the ACT
7 upon taking it for the first time as a junior in 2016 and has
8 the utmost distinction of being a National Merit Scholarship
9 Program semifinalist; and

10 WHEREAS, Lindsey will attend Auburn University on a
11 full tuition scholarship in the fall and pursue aerospace
12 engineering and play flute in the college's orchestra; and

13 WHEREAS, the achievements of this bright, young
14 musician and scholar, who espouses the meritorious
15 characteristics of the U.S. Presidential Scholars Program is a
16 tremendous source of credit to the Alabama School of Fine Arts
17 in Birmingham, and her family and community, as well as the
18 entire State of Alabama, and she is truly deserving of the
19 significant honor bestowed upon her; now therefore,
