17 Alabama and the University of South Alabama, where he earned a
18 Bachelor of Science Degree in Engineering; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Rodgers was employed by the City of
20 Mobile as Information Technology Project Manager in 1998; he
21 was instrumental in improving the technological infrastructure
22 of the City of Mobile and the State of Alabama by developing
23 Mobile 311 and the Geographic Tracking System; and

24 WHEREAS, during his career, Mr. Rodgers was an
25 adjunct instructor at Bishop State Community College, Personal
26 Computer Manager for the Mobile County Health Department, and
27 Chief Information Officer for Searial Industries; he was a

1 graduate of Leadership Mobile and Project Blue Print
2 leadership programs; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Rodgers was remembered as a community
4 servant who worked diligently in the Mobile County area,
5 volunteering countless hours in civic and social organizations
6 to improve the lives of children and impoverished citizens;

8 WHEREAS, survivors include his loving wife, Sonya
9 Cunningham Rodgers; mother, Ida Mae Rodgers; mother-in-law,
10 Carolyn Cunningham; children, Ka'Leah Brianna and Kylen
11 Delano; and granddaughter, Dru Elyse; and

12 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly
13 missed, the cherished memory of Mr. Franklin Delano Rodgers,
14 Jr., will remain in the hearts of all who were honored to know
15 and love him, and were touched by his joyful, giving spirit;
