15 2018 with an unveiling of the Franklin County Historical
16 Marker that will be placed at the Franklin County Archives
17 Building located in Russellville, Alabama; and

19 Pioneer Days Festival at Sloss Lake in Russellville featuring
20 live history demonstrations; and

21 WHEREAS, Franklin County, named in honor of Benjamin
22 Franklin, was established by the Alabama Territorial
23 Legislature in February 1818; and

24 WHEREAS, Franklin County, rich in business and
25 industry, is home to Tiffin Motorhomes, Sunshine Mills,
26 Sunshine Homes, Gates Rubber, G and G Steel, and Pilgrim's
27 Pride; and

1 WHEREAS, it is rich in nature with camping, hiking
2 trails and water recreation at Bear Creek Lakes, Dismals
3 Canyon, Rock Bridge Canyon Equestrian Park, Cypress Cove Farm,
4 and North Alabama Birding Trail; and

5 WHEREAS, Franklin County is rich in attractions with
6 King's Drive-in, Red Bay Family Water Park, Red Bay Museum,
7 and the Historic Roxy Theater; and is known as the Watermelon
8 Capital of Alabama; and

9 WHEREAS, according to a 2000 census, Franklin County
10 has a population of 31,704 residents; and

11 WHEREAS, Franklin County is governed by the Franklin
12 County Commission which is chaired by its Probate Judge and
13 four commissioners; and

14 WHEREAS, celebration of 200 years is a huge
15 milestone and Franklin County is proud of its thriving
16 businesses, quality schools, fertile lands, and its services
17 to the residents who consider it a great place to live, work,
18 and play; now therefore,
