15 WHEREAS, Boys and Girls Clubs provide programs and
16 services with a goal to inspire all young people, especially
17 those from disadvantaged backgrounds, to realize their full
18 potential as productive, responsible, and caring citizens; and

19 WHEREAS, through strong, proven development
20 programs, leaders in the Boys and Girls Clubs stress character
21 and leadership development, education, career advancement, and
22 health and life skills; club leaders encourage an appreciation
23 for the arts and provide programs in sports, fitness, and
24 recreation; and

25 WHEREAS, the programs promote a better self-image
26 and improved education, social, emotional, and cultural

3 WHEREAS, on April 11, 2017, Youth of the Year
4 nominees from Alabama are chosen as the State and the Military
5 Youths of the Year to represent the State of Alabama in the

8 WHEREAS, Alabama Boys and Girls Clubs have named
9 April 11, 2017, as its annual Day at the Capitol; and

10 WHEREAS, through the years, Boys and Girls Clubs
11 have encouraged young people to aspire to the highest level of
12 personal development and to become good citizens who are
13 involved in their communities; now therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
15 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby commend Boys and
16 Girls Clubs across Alabama for the outstanding services they
17 provide to young people and their families.
