4 WHEREAS, survivors include his son, Thomas Mark
5 Coburn (Tammie); daughter, Emily Coburn DaLee; brother, Jim
6 Coburn; and grandchildren, Jeremy Coburn (Amber), Juliana
7 Coburn, Alicia DaLee, and Robert DaLee; and

8 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly
9 missed, the memory of Thomas Coburn will be cherished in the
10 hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefor,
