15 Jesse, Jr., Milton, and Maurice, five grandchildren, Jessica,

17 Jacorey; he tenderly cared for the health of his aging parents
18 until the end; he has greatly influenced the lives of his
19 cousins, nieces, nephews, and friends; and

21 as possible enjoying his passion of deep sea fishing and has
22 organized deep sea fishing trips for family and friends; his
23 exemplary life is aptly depicted by Matthew 4:19-20, "Then he
