2 engaged in politics and numerous civic causes; and

3 WHEREAS, an avid sports fan, Mr. Slack supported the
4 Mobile Mystics Hockey Team, served as an Ambassador for the
5 Mobile Bay Bears, and supported all USA Jaguar Athletics; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Slack was a loyal friend to many and
7 never met a stranger; and

8 WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved and devoted
9 wife of 72 years, the former Betty J. Dunning; three children;
10 seven grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; and many close
11 friends; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Slack was a valued member of the
13 community; although his presence is greatly missed, his memory
14 is cherished in the hearts and minds of all those who were
15 fortunate enough to know him; now therefore,
