12 memory of Mr. Gene Lee Schofield, Jr., by naming mile marker  
13 123 on I-65, near Greenville, Alabama, in his memory; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Scaffield was 27 years of age when he  
15 was struck and killed by a driver who failed to follow the  
16 state's Move Over Law, and was under the influence of alcohol;  
17 state troopers say he was helping a driver on the side of I-65  
18 at the time of the incident; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Schofield, a resident of Fort Deposit,  
20 Alabama, was employed by All About Towing; Vice President Tina  
21 Whatley said, "Gene was a well-respected young man who loved  
22 his job and driving tow trucks"; and

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
24 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in memory of his dedication to  
25 the citizens of Fort Deposit, Alabama, we declare that mile  
26 marker 123 on I-65 near Greenville, Alabama, is named in  
27 memory of Mr. Gene Lee Schofield, Jr.
