12 United States Army Reserve, retiring as a colonel, and having
13 been a commander of the 482nd Replacement Detachment and the
14 1184th Transportation Terminal Battalion; also, he is a
15 veteran of Desert Storm; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Fulford's experience and leadership are
17 indeed worthy of special recognition; now therefore,
