11 WHEREAS, the Reverend T.C. Johnson serves as senior  
12 Pastor at St. Luke Christian Church in Huntsville; a native of  
13 Pike County, Alabama, he has led the church for 35 years; he  
14 has an exhilarating personality that radiates throughout the  
15 North Huntsville community; under the hand of God through the  
16 leadership of Pastor Johnson, the St. Luke Christian Church  
17 has witnessed an extraordinarily progressive increase in
