8 on setting the softball national and AHSAA records with seven
9 straight home runs in seven consecutive plate appearances
10 during a three-game stretch; and

13 Good Hope, and capped the streak with a homer in her first
14 appearance against Locust Fork; and

19 streak and has nine of the team's 12 home runs this season;

21 wins; and

23 are the source of justifiable pride to her family, her school,
24 and the entire Blountsville, Alabama, area; now therefore,
