9 PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS.

11 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, we
12 extend warm commendations to Mrs. Abbiegail Mariam Hamilton
13 Hugine for professional achievements; and

14 WHEREAS, the eldest of eleven children, Mrs.
15 Abbiegail Mariam Hamilton Hugine was born in Green Pond, South
16 Carolina, to Isiah and Viola Wright Hamilton; and

17 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hugine had a very successful 37-year
18 career in education before retiring from Orangeburg
19 Consolidated School District Five, where she served as the
20 Director of The Technology Center and as an instructional
21 leader who monitored and supervised all school operations;
22 during her tenure at The Technology Center, the Center
23 received several awards, including The National Blue Ribbon
24 Schools Award, The Red Carpet School Award, and the Palmetto
25 Gold School Award for four consecutive years; during her
26 career in education, she also served as Assistant Principal,

1 Administrative Assistant, Chair of the Department of Social
2 Studies, and a History and Social Studies teacher; and

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hugine served in numerous professional
4 development activities positions, including as a member of the
5 Orangeburg School District Five Strategic Planning Committee;
6 Chair of the Social Studies Performance Goals; a member of the
7 SREB Making Schools Work Site Visit for Jasper County Public
8 Schools; a consultant in writing test items for the Social
9 Studies Pact Test; Administrative Coordinator for Orangeburg
10 Wilkinson High School Southern Association of Colleges and
11 Schools School Improvement Peer Review Visit; freshman academy
12 administrator; High Schools That Work District Coordinator;
13 SACS Committee Administrative Chairperson; and the presenter
14 for various educational workshops on the local, regional, and
15 national levels; and

16 WHEREAS, in recognition of her exemplary work and
17 service, she received many honors and awards, including, but
18 not limited to, Orangeburg School District Five Teacher of the
19 Year; Orangeburg-Wilkinson High School Teacher of the Year;
20 Outstanding Young Women of America; and Wil Lou Gray
21 Outstanding Educator Award; and

22 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hugine devotes much of her time to God
23 and the church; she is a member of St. John AME Church and
24 serves on the Church Steward Board, The History Makers
25 Committee, and the Missionary Society; she is active in other
26 kinds of organizations as well, including The Greater
27 Huntsville Chapter of Links, Inc., and Epsilon Gamma Omega

1 Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.; also, she
2 initiated the First Lady's Scholarship Fund to raise
3 scholarship money for students attending Alabama A and M
4 University, as well as the Normalite Pavers Scholarship to
5 assist students who are in need of financial help to graduate;

7 WHEREAS, she has received the Educational Specialist
8 Degree from the Citadel, and she has received a Master of
9 Education and a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Carolina State
10 University; and

11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hugine is married to Andrew Hugine,
12 Jr., who is the President of Alabama A and M University; she
13 and her husband have two children, Andrew, III, (Karen) and
14 Akilah (Quincy Elmore), a grandson, Amir, and a granddaughter,
15 Nylah; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hugine is indeed a remarkable and
17 inspiring woman who is deserving of special recognition; now
