12 Mann for service as a member and President of the Montgomery
13 Tuskegee Alumni Club; and

14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mann is a 1973 Business Management
15 graduate of Tuskegee University; in 1978, she became a member
16 of the Montgomery Tuskegee Alumni Club and became the chair of
17 the Ways and Means Committee; due to her ingenuity, she was
18 given the task of developing fundraising and entertainment for
19 the club; as a result of setting up a "Putting on the Hits"
20 contest, working with local DJs and radio personalities, the
21 membership of the club began to increase; in 1985, she was
22 elected as vice president and served two terms and became
23 active with the Tuskegee Alumni Southeast Region and the
24 Tuskegee National Alumni Association; and

25 WHEREAS, in 1989, Mrs. Mann was elected president of
26 the Montgomery Tuskegee Alumni Club and has served in that
27 position for 30 years; during her tenure she has achieved many

1 firsts, some of which include the MTAC newsletter, a
2 fundraiser featuring a New York Broadway Play at the Davis
3 Theater, MTAC homecoming fundraiser, Turkey Day alumni
4 reception, bus trips for sporting events, and created an MTAC
5 t-shirt, and souvenir ad journal for banquets; and many other
6 innovative programs for the club; and

7 WHEREAS, in 1998, she was elected as Tuskegee Alumni
8 Southeast Region Director and served in that position until
9 2003; she instituted many cutting edge programs and was
10 instrumental in getting the region to establish an emergency
11 fund for Southeast Region students; during her tenure as SER
12 Director seven clubs were established or reactivated; she was
13 very active in the club and accomplished many goals; she led
14 the local club to new heights with its annual fundraiser; and

15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mann never lets anything deter her
16 from being actively involved in working with the club, going
17 out on recruiting events, attending conferences or
18 volunteering to work with regional and national events; due to
19 her tenacity, the club has increased its membership and
20 continues to raise monies for the scholarship fund; during her
21 tenure as president, over 100 scholarships were awarded to
22 local area students; she has received many awards and
23 accolades for her dedication and hard work with Tuskegee,
24 TNAA, SER, and MTAC; now therefore,
