6 WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature wishes to honor the
7 memory of Mr. Gene Lee Schofield, Jr., by naming mile marker
8 123 on I-65, near Greenville, Alabama, in his memory; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Schofield was 27 years of age when he
10 was struck and killed by a driver who failed to follow the
11 state's Move Over Law, and was under the influence of alcohol;
12 state troopers say he was helping a driver on the side of I-65
13 at the time of the incident; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Schofield, a resident of Fort Deposit,
15 Alabama, was employed by All About Towing; Vice President Tina
16 Whatley said, "Gene was a well-respected young man who loved
17 his job and driving tow trucks"; and

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
19 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in memory of his dedication to
20 the citizens of Fort Deposit, Alabama, we declare that mile
21 marker 123 on I-65 near Greenville, Alabama, is named in
22 memory of Mr. Gene Lee Schofield, Jr.
