8 COMMENDING CALHOUN COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTY TYLER
9 PECK AS A NOMINEE FOR THE 2019 ALABAMA LEGISLATIVE MEDAL OF
10 HONOR FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

12 WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
13 recognize Calhoun County Sheriff's Deputy Tyler Peck as a
14 nominee for the 2019 Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor for
15 Law Enforcement, Alabama's highest law enforcement award for
16 extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

17 WHEREAS, on August 17, 2018, at about 9:50 PM,
18 Deputy Peck arrived on the scene of a shots fired call; the
19 residents informed Deputy Peck that they heard multiple gun
20 shots fired from behind their residence; the deputy instructed
21 the callers to remain inside and he began a search of the
22 property; he located the victim and found him severely
23 wounded, but conscious; the victim told Deputy Peck that he
24 did not know if the shooter was still on the scene, but he had
25 returned gunfire with his shotgun; Deputy Peck called for
26 backup and EMS; he then applied a life-saving tourniquet to
27 the victim's leg; despite their exposed position and the

reduced visibility caused by rain and darkness, Deputy Peck continued to apply lifesaving measures to the victim until back up arrived; as a result of the quick action taken by Deputy Peck, the victim survived his wounds; Deputy Peck is 22 years old and had recently completed his field training; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Tyler Peck demonstrated immense courage, diligence, and quick response in a life-threatening situation; his loyalty and unwavering commitment to protect and serve the residents of Calhoun County were evidenced through his willingness to make the quick and proper response in order to protect the lives of others; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Peck epitomizes the qualities of those who serve and protect, and he is truly deserving of this distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize and honor Calhoun County Sheriff's Deputy Tyler Peck as a nominee for the 2019 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement and direct that he receive a copy of this resolution as evidence of our admiration and esteem.
