COMMENDING CALHOUN COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTY TYLER
PECK AS A NOMINEE FOR THE 2019 ALABAMA LEGISLATIVE MEDAL OF
HONOR FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
recognize Calhoun County Sheriff's Deputy Tyler Peck as a
nominee for the 2019 Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor for
Law Enforcement, Alabama's highest law enforcement award for
extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2018, at about 9:50 PM,
Deputy Peck arrived on the scene of a shots fired call; the
residents informed Deputy Peck that they heard multiple gun
shots fired from behind their residence; the deputy instructed
the callers to remain inside and he began a search of the
property; he located the victim and found him severely
wounded, but conscious; the victim told Deputy Peck that he
did not know if the shooter was still on the scene, but he had
returned gunfire with his shotgun; Deputy Peck called for
backup and EMS; he then applied a life-saving tourniquet to
the victim's leg; despite their exposed position and the

1 reduced visibility caused by rain and darkness, Deputy Peck
2 continued to apply lifesaving measures to the victim until
3 back up arrived; as a result of the quick action taken by
4 Deputy Peck, the victim survived his wounds; Deputy Peck is 22
5 years old and had recently completed his field training; and

6 WHEREAS, Deputy Tyler Peck demonstrated immense
7 courage, diligence, and quick response in a life-threatening
8 situation; his loyalty and unwavering commitment to protect
9 and serve the residents of Calhoun County were evidenced
10 through his willingness to make the quick and proper response
11 in order to protect the lives of others; and

12 WHEREAS, Deputy Peck epitomizes the qualities of
13 those who serve and protect, and he is truly deserving of this
14 distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor
15 for Law Enforcement; now therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
17 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize and honor
18 Calhoun County Sheriff's Deputy Tyler Peck as a nominee for
19 the 2019 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement and
20 direct that he receive a copy of this resolution as evidence
21 of our admiration and esteem.
