2 60 years; she served as president of the Trinity Baptist  
3 Church Missionary Society and provided stalwart support to the  
4 Mt. Pilgrim Baptist District Association; she enjoyed working  
5 and traveling with the Sunbeams to Selma University for the  
6 Alabama State and National Conventions as a delegate; she also  
7 served on the No. 2 Usher Board for Trinity Baptist Church;

9 WHEREAS, her survivors include a daughter, eight  
10 grandchildren, 24 great-grandchildren, and eight  
11 great-great-grandchildren, and a host of other relatives and  
12 many friends; and

13 WHEREAS, her presence will be greatly missed, but

15 knew and loved her; now therefore,
