13 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity,  
14 Incorporated, was founded January 5, 1911, on the campus of  
15 Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana; the fraternity's  
16 fundamental purpose, "achievement in every field of human  
17 endeavor," continues today and was best demonstrated by the  
18 fraternity's ten prestigious founders, the majority of whom  
19 obtained degrees and became very successful in their fields;  
20 there are more than 150,000 members of Kappa Alpha Psi with  
21 over 721 undergraduate, alumni, and international chapters;  
22 Kappa Alpha Psi sponsors programs providing community service,  
23 social welfare and academic scholarship through the Kappa  
24 Alpha Psi Foundation; and

25 WHEREAS, there are five core objectives of Kappa  
26 Alpha Psi, which are: To unite college men of culture,  
27 patriotism, and honor in a bond of fraternity; encourage

1 honorable achievement in every field of human endeavor;  
2 promote spiritual, social, intellectual, and moral welfare of  
3 its members; assist in the aims and purposes of colleges and  
4 universities; and inspire service in the public interest; and

5                   WHEREAS, the fundamental purpose of Kappa Alpha Psi  
6 as envisioned and verbalized by the founding fathers gives  
7 this organization its unique and distinguished aspects; they  
8 sought to "shape a group personality unique in the annals of

12 Alabama House of Representatives, the ranking Minority Leader,  
13 Anthony Daniels; the House Black Caucus Chairman, A.J.
