9 JEFFERSON COUNTY THE KENNETH SHERWOOD EBAUGH MEMORIAL

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Kenneth Sherwood Ebaugh was born on  
13 July 24, 1951, in Birmingham, Alabama, to Reverend John Lynn  
14 Ebaugh, III, and Joy Richard Ebaugh; he graduated from  
15 Birmingham-Southern College in 1973, where he was a member of  
16 Theta Chi fraternity; he earned an MBA from The University of  
17 Alabama at Birmingham in 1979, and retired as a Vice President  
18 of Regions Bank; and

19 WHEREAS, he was a firm believer in continuing  
20 education; he was the first person in 21 years to win both the  
21 Highest Grade Award and the BankSim Presidents' Award from the  
22 Alabama School of Banking in 1996; he believed strongly in  
23 public service and served proudly as a Past President of the  
24 Kiwanis Club of Homewood and Mountain Brook, where he was a  
25 member for more than 40 years; he was the recipient of the  
26 prestigious George F. Hixon Fellowship, which recognizes those  
27 who have contributed significantly to the Kiwanis Club's

1 history of generosity; he was also a member of the Ensley  
2 Rotary, as well as other civic organizations; he attended St.  
3 Stephens Episcopal Church in Vestavia Hills; and

4 WHEREAS, the death of Mr. Ebaugh on January 28,  
5 2019, is recorded with deep sadness, and it is befitting to  
6 memorialize his many contributions to the community and this  
7 state; now therefore,

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
9 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we declare that the crosswalk  
10 crossing Shades Creek Parkway at the entrance to Brookwood  
11 Mall in Jefferson County, be named the "Kenneth Sherwood  
12 Ebaugh Memorial Crosswalk."

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate  
14 officials be requested to place and maintain signs or markers  
15 as provided in this resolution.
