11 are transforming every area of our lives; and

12 WHEREAS, with great pride and pleasure, we recognize  
13 Alabama's technology industry and emerging technology job  
14 sector's impact on the state's workforce and economy; and

15 WHEREAS, the resources that are invested into  
16 Alabama's technology industry and advanced, emerging  
17 technologies are critical to creating the industries of the  
18 future, including autonomous cars, industrial robots, and  
19 algorithms for disease diagnosis; and

20 WHEREAS, as rapid technological innovations take  
21 place, Alabama's technology sector continues to improve the  
22 lives of people, create jobs, reflect our Nation's values, and  
23 keep our fellow citizens safe; and

24 WHEREAS, Alabama's technology sector has grown with  
25 more than 148,000 employees; technology accounts for

1 approximately 7.2 percent of Alabama's overall workforce;  
 2 also, the technology sector had an estimated direct economic  
 3 impact of 14.5 billion dollars, which is about 7.1 percent of  
 4 Alabama's total economy; and

5 WHEREAS, tens of thousands of people rely on  
 6 technology in the workplace; the broad-based impact of the  
 7 technology industry touches every community, company, and  
 8 industry market across Alabama; and

9 WHEREAS, Alabama has seen a 57 percent increase in  
 10 the number of job postings related to emerging technologies,  
 11 smart cities, drones, artificial intelligence, virtual and  
 12 augmented reality, and blockchain; and

13 WHEREAS, in 2021, Cyberstates reports that net new  
 14 technology employment in Alabama will grow by nearly two  
 15 percent, and by the year 2026, net technology employment will  
 16 grow by 6.8 percent in Alabama; and

17 WHEREAS, Alabama's technology industry and advanced  
 18 technology sector are having a positive impact on the state's  
 19 workforce and economy now and in the future; now therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
 21 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Alabama's technology sector,  
 22 technology innovators, and technology job creators are  
 23 commended, and this resolution is dedicated to them in highest  
 24 esteem and gratitude.
