WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that Judge Julian B. "Buddy" Brackin, Jr. is recognized for his distinguished record of professional achievement and dedicated service for serving on the Judicial Bench for 31 years for the City of Orange Beach, Alabama; and

8 Baldwin County Bar Association and a former member of the
9 Baldwin Judiciary Selection Committee; he serves on the
10 Standing Committee on Practice and Procedure; he is registered
11 on the Alabama State Court Mediator Roster; and

12 WHEREAS, Judge Brackin has earned immense respect
13 for his tireless dedication and exceptional abilities for his
14 many years of service to the City of Orange Beach and across
15 the municipalities of Baldwin County, and he is truly
16 deserving of special recognition; now therefore,
