11 WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that Judge
12 Julian B. "Buddy" Brackin, Jr. is recognized for his
13 distinguished record of professional achievement and dedicated
14 service for serving on the Judicial Bench for 31 years for the
15 City of Orange Beach, Alabama; and

16 WHEREAS, Judge Brackin is retiring from the
17 Municipal Judgeship for the City of Orange Beach; he grew up
18 in Faunsdale, Alabama, and was a graduate of Thomaston High
19 School; he attended Marion Military Institute for one year and
20 graduated from Troy University in 1972; he attended The
21 University of Alabama School of Law obtaining his Doctor of
22 Jurisprudence in 1976, as well as a Master's Degree in Public
23 Administration; after law school, he was employed by the State
24 of Alabama Attorney General's Office; he relocated to Baldwin
25 County, Alabama, forming his own law firm, which later became
26 known as Brackin, McGriff, and Johnson, PC; and

1 WHEREAS, Judge Brackin has served as the Municipal
2 Judge for the City of Orange Beach, Alabama, and the City of
3 Robertsdale, Alabama, since 1980 and 1994, respectively; he
4 previously served as the Municipal Judge for the Town of
5 Elberta, Alabama, for 18 years and the Town of Summerdale,
6 Alabama, for 7 years; and

7 WHEREAS, Judge Brackin is past president of the
8 Baldwin County Bar Association and a former member of the
9 Baldwin Judiciary Selection Committee; he serves on the
10 Standing Committee on Practice and Procedure; he is registered
11 on the Alabama State Court Mediator Roster; and

12 WHEREAS, Judge Brackin has earned immense respect
13 for his tireless dedication and exceptional abilities for his
14 many years of service to the City of Orange Beach and across
15 the municipalities of Baldwin County, and he is truly
16 deserving of special recognition; now therefore,

18 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING,
