6 REGISTERED NURSE ANESTHETISTS WEEK IN THE STATE OF ALABAMA.

8 WHEREAS, the week of January 23 through January 29,
9 2022, is nationally recognized as Certified Registered Nurse
10 Anesthetists Week to honor Nurse Anesthetists and their
11 commitment to patients, their dedication to the public, and
12 their continued service; and

13 WHEREAS, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists are
14 advanced practice registered nurses who have provided
15 anesthesia care to patients in the United States for more than
16 150 years; Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists are among
17 the nation's most trusted health care professionals; and

18 WHEREAS, Legislation passed by the United States
19 Congress in 1986 made Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists
20 the first nursing specialty to be accorded direct
21 reimbursement rights by Medicare; and

22 WHEREAS, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists are
23 primary anesthesia providers in rural communities and continue
24 to be primary providers of anesthesia care to United States
25 military personnel; and

1 WHEREAS, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists
2 practice in every setting in which anesthesia is delivered,
3 including traditional hospital surgical suites, obstetrical
4 delivery rooms, critical access hospitals, ambulatory surgical
5 centers, offices of dentists, podiatrists, ophthalmologists,
6 pain management specialists, and many more; and

7 WHEREAS, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists are
8 qualified to make independent judgements regarding all aspects
9 of anesthesia care based on their education, training, and
10 licensure; and

11 WHEREAS, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists are
12 trusted anesthesia experts on the frontlines, caring for
13 patients safely, compassionately, and delivering specialized,
14 cost effective care to all patients, from newborns to seniors,
15 for every type of procedure; and

16 WHEREAS, Alabama benefits daily from the knowledge
17 and skills of highly trained individuals who work as Certified
18 Registered Nurse Anesthetists; they are courageously serving
19 on the frontlines of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, using
20 their skills in airway management, intubation, and ventilator
21 management care for the sickest of patients; Certified
22 Registered Nurse Anesthetists leave their homes and families
23 to travel to hospitals and facilities across the country so
24 they can assist where the need is the greatest; now therefore,
