WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the death on January 10, 2022, of Mr. Melvin Gene Bowling at the age of 88; and

WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the entire community, where he was highly regarded; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bowling was born on March 2, 1933, to John Roy and Cora Lee Bowling in Lacey's Spring in Morgan County, Alabama; he graduated from Union Hill High School in 1950 leading its basketball team to a 39-1 record and a State Championship; his ability to "Shine" on the court earned him the nickname which stayed with him throughout his life; he attended The University of Alabama, playing basketball and running track for the Crimson Tide; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bowling was a loving husband, son, father, grandfather, pilot, and missionary; proudly serving his country in the United States Air Force for 28 years, Mr. Bowling retired in 1982 as a Major General; his vast military

1 career included tours in Vietnam and Korea; he is the
2 recipient of the Silver Star, Legion of Merit, and the
3 Distinguished Flying Cross; and

4 WHEREAS, always the family man, Mr. Bowling left his
5 distinguished military career to enable his family to remain
6 in one place; after accepting Jesus around the time of his
7 retirement, ministering to all those he met became his passion
8 and mission; almost every encounter ended with a transition
9 from business proposals to Mr. Bowling asking, "Now how is
10 your relationship with the Lord?"; few met him without being
11 handed a Precious Bible Promises or Oswald Chambers book; his
12 faith was like his stature, life, and commitment to his family
13 and friends - big and contagious; and

14 WHEREAS, he is predeceased by his parents and
15 brother, James Roy "Bobo" Bowling; he is survived by his wife
16 of 63 years, Joan Bowling; sons, Mike Bowling (Rainer) and Jim
17 Bowling (Cheri); grandchildren, John Michael Bowling, Lucy
18 Bowling, Jake Bowling, Sam Bowling, Mathew Bowling, and
19 Johnathan Bowling; and a host of other relatives and many
20 friends; and

22 missed, the memory of Mr. Bowling will be cherished in the
