11 the death on February 6, 2022, of Mr. Adas Jean "AJ" Sankey at
12 the age of 99 years; and

17 Will and Leoner Spann Sankey in West Virginia; and

21 Superintendent; he served his country in the United States

26 Assistant Fire Chief for the Screamer Volunteer Fire
27 Department; he was a member of the Magnolia Lodge #218 as a

2 Conference for many years; and

3 WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his infant son,
4 Willie Lee Sankey; and daughter, Patricia Ward; and

5 WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved wife, Mrs.
6 Christine Spann Sankey; sons, Robert Sankey (Nelli), Larry
7 Sankey (Marion), and Ricky Grubbs (Barbara Ann) Willie Sankey;
8 daughters, Barbara Ann Grimsley (Clarence), Leoner Isom, Mary
9 Joyce Lynn (Artis) and Sandra Grubbs; twenty-two
10 grand-children; special grandson, Rickey Dozier (Arica);
11 special niece, Delories Spells; and a host of other family and
