8 WHEREAS, it is with great honor that we extend  
9 highest commendations to Colonel David B. Etheredge for his  
10 many dedicated years of service to the United States Air  
11 Force; he serves as the Commander of the 117th Maintenance  
12 Group, Sumpter Smith Air National Guard Base, in Birmingham,  
13 Alabama, and is a a Senior Evaluator Pilot on the KC-135R/T  
14 with the Alabama Air National Guard; as Group Commander, he is  
15 responsible for over 300 personnel in a TFA ANG Active  
16 Associate Wing to generate and execute nine KC-135R aircraft  
17 to provide worldwide aerial refueling and airlift missions;

19 WHEREAS, moving through the ranks over the years,  
20 Colonel Etheredge was promoted to Second Lieutenant on June 9,  
21 1994; First Lieutenant on June 23, 1996; Captain on June 23,  
22 1998; Major on July 2, 2002; Lieutenant Colonel on July 2,  
23 2009; and Colonel on January 1, 2019; he is a highly decorated  
24 pilot, holding a Meritorious Service Medal with one Oak Leaf  
25 Cluster, an Air Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters, and an

1 Aerial Achievement Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster, who has  
2 accumulated more than 5,100 flying hours; the aircraft that he  
3 has flown are T-37, T-38, and KC-135R/T; and

4 WHEREAS, during his career, Colonel Etheredge has  
5 served in a variety of positions at the squadron, group, and  
6 wing levels, including, Operations Support Squadron Commander,  
7 Chief of Wing Tactics, and Chief of Aircrew Training;  
8 furthermore, he is a veteran of operations Joint Forge, Iraqi  
9 Freedom, Enduring Freedom, Northern Watch, Southern Watch,  
10 Inherent Resolve, Freedom's Sentinel, and Noble Eagle, flying  
11 over 220 combat and combat support sorties in the KC-135;  
12 also, he is a Flying Safety Officer, an Aircraft Mishap  
13 Investigator, and the Safety and Accident Investigation Board  
14 President; and

15 WHEREAS, Colonel Etheredge earned a Bachelor of  
16 Science Degree in Business Administration from Auburn  
17 University in Auburn, Alabama, in 1989; and a Master of  
18 Business Administration Degree from The University of Alabama  
19 at Birmingham in 1997; furthermore, he graduated from Squadron  
20 Officer School at Maxwell Air Force Base in Alabama in 2000,  
21 Air Command and Staff College at Maxwell Airforce Base in  
22 Alabama in 2004, and Air War College at Maxwell Air Force Base  
23 in Alabama in 2014; and

24 WHEREAS, Colonel Etheredge's unwavering bravery,  
25 steadfast selflessness, and diligent commitment to serving

1 others make him an incredible leader and friend in the lives  
2 of many; now therefore,
