12 years and has served as Trustee, Elder, and Moderator of the
13 Board; she is also an avid supporter of children and youth
14 programs in her community; Dr. Meyer helped to establish a
15 special scholarship fund to assist students with their higher
16 education goals; and

18 Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and
19 Certification (NASDTEC) Distinguished Leadership Award for her
20 K-12 teacher preparation and certification efforts; and
