7 the death on February 20, 2022, of Mrs. Juliet deVilliers  
8 Miller Beale of Birmingham, Alabama, at the age of 74 years;

2 the Order of St. John; and

3 WHEREAS, survivors include her beloved husband,  
4 Walter McFarland Beale, Jr.; daughter, Miller Beale Girvin  
5 (Josh); brothers, James Hugh Miller, III (Kathy), and Robert  
6 Boyd Miller (Ginger); sister, Ashley Miller Crosler (Rick);  
7 granddaughters, Juliet Hamilton Girvin and Margaret Bibb  
8 Girvin; and a host of other family and friends; and

10 missed, the memory of Mrs. Beale will be cherished in the  
11 hearts of all who knew and loved her; now therefore,
