WHEREAS, roots dating back to ancient Egypt

of Lewis and Clark contributed to historical mapping of the
United States; and

WHEREAS, surveying property requires long hours in
varying terrains performing various types of mapping and
surveying, including geodetic, hydrographic, engineering,
cartographic, and topographical surveys, to gather data to
establish land ownership, infrastructure, and geographic
information for systems development, and implementing
