CONGRATULATING TREY CUNNINGHAM FOR WINNING THE 2022
NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION 60-METER NATIONAL
CHAMPIONSHIP.

WHEREAS, highest congratulations are herein proudly
presented to Trey Cunningham for winning the 2022 National
Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) 60-meter National
Championship in Birmingham, Alabama, on Saturday, March 12,
2022; and

WHEREAS, through diligence and a commitment to
excellence, Trey continuously achieves one accomplishment
after another; he is the only athlete in NCAA history to run
7.42 or faster four separate times, and he won his fifth
consecutive ACC title in the 60-meter hurdles, attaining the
second and third fastest times in NCAA history in 60-meter
hurdles; the most accomplished high school hurdler to ever
sign at Florida State University, Trey broke the U20 World
Record twice on his way to the 2017 New Balance Indoor
National Championship in the 60-meter hurdles, running 7.40 in
the final; and

1 WHEREAS, Trey is a Florida State University record
2 holder in the 60-meter hurdles and an ACC Record Holder in the
3 60-meter hurdles, and he became the first Nole to be named
4 USTFCCCA Men's National Athlete of the Week; his other honors
5 include 2022 ACC Indoor Champion-60H, 2022 Indoor First Team
6 All-ACC, 2021 Indoor T and F South Region Athlete of the Year,
7 2021 Indoor T and F All-American-60H, 2021 Outdoor T and F
8 All-ACC First Team-110H, 2021 Indoor T and F 60H ACC Champion,
9 2021 Outdoor T and F 110H ACC Champion, 2021 Indoor T and F
10 ACC Scholar-Athlete of the Year, 2021 Indoor T and F Academic
11 All-ACC Team, 2021 Outdoor T and F Academic All-ACC Team, 2020
12 ACC Indoor Track Performer of the Year, 2020 ACC Indoor Track
13 Scholar of the Year, 2018 ACC Indoor Freshman of the Year, and
14 2018 ACC Outdoor Freshman of the Year; and

15 WHEREAS, the 24-time Alabama State Champion for
16 Winfield City High School who has won 20 individual titles is
17 the son of Brad and Shelly Cunningham; and

18 WHEREAS, a talented and committed young man with a
19 very bright future ahead of him, Trey is an inspiration to
20 many in his community and beyond; now therefore,
