10 Representative Shiver is also a Member of the Bureau of Indian
11 Affairs; and

13 back to his community and received the "Volunteer of the Year"
14 award in 2002 from the North Baldwin Chamber of Commerce;
15 Representative Shiver served as Chairperson and Board Member
16 of the North Baldwin Chamber of Commerce; he is a member of
17 the Juvenile Conference Committee, member of the Board of
18 Directors of the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program,
19 Chairperson of the Patrons of Bay Minette Middle School, a
20 Member of the Mystic Revelers and the North Baldwin Search and
21 Rescue Squad, and a former volunteer for the Boy Scouts of
22 America and United Way of Baldwin County; Representative
23 Shiver is a certified hunter safety instructor and a member of
24 the state organization for hunter safety, member of the Fort
25 Mims Historical Society, Key Club, and a 50-year member of the
26 Masons; member of the Baldwin County High School Athletic Hall
27 of Fame; member of the Baldwin County Middle School Hall of
