8 NAMING THE BRIDGES ON U.S. HIGHWAY 72 IN LAUDERDALE
9 COUNTY OVER SECOND CREEK AS REPRESENTATIVE LYNN GREER WAY.

11 WHEREAS, it is with the highest accolade that this
12 body renames bridge BIN 11181 carrying U.S. Highway 72 traffic
13 west bound over Second Creek in Lauderdale County and bridge
14 BIN 20349 carrying U.S. Highway 72 traffic east bound over
15 Second Creek in Lauderdale County, together, as Representative
16 Lynn Greer Way; and

17 WHEREAS, Representative Greer was first elected to
18 the Alabama House of Representatives in 1974 and has served a
19 total of six terms - three consecutively since 2010, and his
20 public service career also includes nine years on the Public
21 Service Commission; and

22 WHEREAS, some of Representative Greer's most
23 noteworthy legislation includes laws that have directed most
24 of the Tennessee Valley Authority's in lieu of taxes funds to
25 counties and communities in north Alabama, gaining Lauderdale
26 County alone approximately \$155 million since 1981; and

1 WHEREAS, Representative Greer's service to his
2 district and to this state has earned him the admiration and
3 respect of his fellow legislators and Alabamians, and it is
4 both appropriate and desirable to honor him for his dedicated
5 service; now therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
7 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That bridge BIN 11181 carrying U.S.
8 Highway 72 traffic west bound over Second Creek in Lauderdale
9 County and bridge BIN 20349 carrying U.S. Highway 72 traffic
10 east bound over Second Creek in Lauderdale County, together,
11 be designated as Representative Lynn Greer Way.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of
13 Transportation is required to coordinate with the local
14 governing officials on fabricating and erecting appropriate
15 signs or markers, consistent with applicable requirements and
16 laws, in recognition of this designation.
