5                 This bill would allow a commercial driver who  
6     holds a valid Transportation Worker Identification  
7     Credential from the Transportation Security  
8     Administration to obtain or renew a Hazardous Materials  
9     Endorsement from the Alabama State Law Enforcement  
10    Agency.

17                 Relating to commercial driver licenses; to require the  
18     Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency to issue a Hazardous  
19     Materials Endorsement in certain circumstances.

20     BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21                 Section 1. (a) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency  
22     shall issue a Hazardous Materials Endorsement or renew an  
23     existing Hazardous Materials Endorsement to an individual who  
24     holds a valid Transportation Worker Identification Credential  
25     issued by the federal Transportation Security Administration,  
26     provided the agency verifies that the Transportation Worker  
27     Identification Credential is valid, and the expiration date of  
28     the Hazardous Materials Endorsement is no later than the

29 existing Transportation Worker Identification Credential  
30 expiration date.

31 (b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may adopt  
32 rules to implement this section.

33 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first  
34 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
35 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
