SYNOPSIS:

This bill would allow a commercial driver who holds a valid Transportation Worker Identification Credential from the Transportation Security Administration to obtain or renew a Hazardous Materials Endorsement from the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to commercial driver licenses; to require the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency to issue a Hazardous Materials Endorsement in certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency shall issue a Hazardous Materials Endorsement or renew an existing Hazardous Materials Endorsement to an individual who holds a valid Transportation Worker Identification Credential issued by the federal Transportation Security Administration, provided the agency verifies that the Transportation Worker Identification Credential is valid, and the expiration date of the Hazardous Materials Endorsement is no later than the

31 (b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may adopt  
32 rules to implement this section.

33 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first  
34 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
35 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
