4 HR\_\_\_\_\_ COMMENDING ED LETT ON HIS CAREER AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

6 WHEREAS, Ed Lett is the most prolific passer in  
7 Jacksonville State University history; during his brilliant  
8 career, 1979-1982, he threw for 7,092 yards and 61  
9 touchdowns; and

10 WHEREAS, a native of Glencoe, Lett established 24  
11 game, season, and career passing records, and all of them  
12 still stand, including the most touchdown passes in one  
13 season,22; and

14 WHEREAS, during the 1981 season he tossed four  
15 touchdown passes in three separate games; as the starting  
16 quarterback for three years, Lett led the Gamecocks to a  
17 26-8 record, a pair of Gulf South Conference Championships  
18 and three consecutive trips to the NCAA Division II  
19 playoffs; and

20 WHEREAS, a two-time All-GSC performer, Lett was named  
21 the Gulf South Conference "Offensive Player of the Year" in  
22 1981 and 1982 as well as the Alabama Sportswriters'  
23 Association "Amateur Athlete of the Year" in 1981; he was  
24 also named the Kodak and Associated Press All American in  
25 1981 and 1982; and

26 WHEREAS, Ed Lett, played quarterback from 1976-1977  
27 at Glencoe High School and from 1978-1982 at Jacksonville  
28 State; the Yellow Jackets went 18-2 during Lett's junior and

29 senior seasons; he threw for 1,407 yards and 15 touchdowns  
30 during the 1977 season, after which he was selected as  
31 Etowah County MVP and made the Class 3A All-State team;  
32 while at JSU, Lett threw for 7,092 yards and 61 touchdowns  
33 while establishing several game, season, and career passing  
34 records, and he was inducted into the JSU Athletic Hall of  
35 Fame in 1996; and

36 WHEREAS, Ed Lett was the Associate Athletic Director  
37 for External Affairs at Jacksonville State; he retired from  
38 that position in 2023; and

39 WHEREAS, more than the above accolades, Ed has been a  
40 tremendous ambassador for the City of Glencoe, Glencoe's  
41 athletic programs and all of Etowah County; he has had great  
42 success in all endeavors of life but remains humble and has  
43 never forgotten his roots; now therefore,

44 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
45 LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Ed Lett is highly honored and  
46 commended, and this resolution is offered to him with
