BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That immediately upon the adoption of this resolution, the following business, in the order set forth below, shall be the special and paramount order of business for the tenth legislative day taking precedence over the regular order of business or any pending or unfinished business.

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Representatives Garrett:

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HB129 (w/sub)

Creating Hope and Opportunity for Our Students' Education (CHOOSE) Act of 2024, established to provide education savings accounts (ESAs) for parents of children to use in providing education services for those children.

Representatives Shaw:

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HB82 (w/sub)

Crimes and offenses; falsely reporting; penalties revised; restitution required

Representatives Hulsey:

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HB126 (w/sub)

Fire-protection personnel and emergency medical services personnel, annual training related to individuals with sensory needs and certain disabilities, required



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Representatives Robbins:

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HB164 (w/sub)

Consumer Protection; online distribution of material harmful to minors, prohibited; online age-verification requirements, required

Representative Clarke:

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HB101 (w/sub)

Elections; providing additional items to be considered election expenses that must be reimbursed to the counties by the state

Representative McCampbell:

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HB70

Board of Dental Examiners of Alabama, to create limited special volunteer licenses for nonresident dentists and dental hygienists, to increase fee for annual dental hygiene registration, to add fee for issuance of special volunteer licenses
