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6 WHEREAS, it is with profound sadness that we note
7 the death of Mrs. Patricia Haddoch Woller on March 3, 2024,
8 at the age of 84 years; and

9 WHEREAS, her passing leaves a void in the lives of
10 her loving family, many friends, and the entire community
11 where she was highly regarded; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Woller, a former councilwoman and
13 school board member, dedicated 24 years of her life to
14 public service in Decatur, Alabama, leaving a legacy of
15 commitment and community engagement; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Woller's life was a testament to her
17 dedication to family and community; she balanced her public
18 roles with being a supportive partner in her husband John
19 Woller, Sr.'s business, Summit Tree Stands; and

20 WHEREAS, her service on the Decatur City Board of
21 Education and City Council reflected her passion for the
22 city's welfare; her leadership helped shape the educational
23 landscape and city governance, leaving an indelible mark on
24 Decatur; and

25 WHEREAS, her approach to service was characterized a
26 deep understanding of the issues and a commitment to
27 progress; she played a pivotal role in the creation of the
28 city's first strategic plan for the school system; and



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29 WHEREAS, during her terms in office, Mrs. Woller was
30 known for her clear stance on city issues and her unwavering
31 representation of Decatur's interests; her leadership during
32 challenging times, including the contentious debate over a
33 sales tax increase, demonstrated her courage and dedication;

35 WHEREAS Mrs. Woller was preceded in death by her
36 parents; grandson, David Woller; and her beloved husband of
37 62 years, John; and

38 WHEREAS, survivors include her children, John Jr.
39 (Suzanne), Ronald (Melinda), Will (Kay), and Janet;
40 grandchildren, Joey (Lauren), John III (Valerie), Caroline,
41 Leta (Andrew), Sarah Catherine (Eric), Patricia (Kyle),
42 William (Kileigh), Llewellyn, Margaret, and Leah; and six
43 great-granddaughters; and a host of other relatives and
