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4 SYNOPSIS:

5 Existing law does not provide experience credit
6 to certified teachers for years worked as a
7 paraprofessional or classroom teacher's aide before
8 they were certified.

9 This bill would provide certified teachers with
10 one year of experience credit on the local salary
11 schedule for every two years that he or she previously
12 worked as a paraprofessional or classroom teacher's
13 aide at a public school in this state, provided that he
14 or she has a minimum of four years total experience.

15 This bill would only apply to certified teachers
16 hired on or after June 1, 2024.

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23 Relating to public education; to add Section 16-23-25
24 to the Code of Alabama 1975; to provide certain certified
25 teachers who previously worked as a paraprofessional or
26 classroom teacher's aide with experience credit on the local
27 salary schedule.

28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:



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Section 1. Section 16-23-25 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

§16-23-25

(a) A teacher with at least four years of full-time experience as a paraprofessional or classroom teacher's aide in a public school who is: (i) issued a teacher certificate pursuant to this chapter; and (ii) hired into a position requiring such certification, shall receive one year of experience credit on the local teacher salary schedule established pursuant to Section 16-13-231.1 for every two years of full-time experience that he or she earned in a public school as a paraprofessional or classroom teacher's aide prior to being hired as a certified teacher.

(b) This section shall only apply to teachers hired into a position requiring teacher certification on or after June 1, 2024.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1, 2024.
